The successor to the 2-Litre Sports model, it had a comparatively advanced dual overhead cam 2.6 L straight-6 engine in place of the previous pushrod straight-4.It was available as a closed, 2-door, 2-seater coupé which Aston Martin called a sports saloon, and later also as a drophead ...

The DB2 was available as a two-seat, two-door fixed head coupe, or as a drop head coupe. When the change was made to the DB2/4 in 1953, Aston added a fastback coupe to the line, which was technically a 2+2 with limited back seat space. Astons of this era featured hand-formed aluminum bodywork hung on a tubular steel chassis.
