The New Imperialism In the late 19th century (1880's), a new phase of Western expansion and an intense scramble for new territory began. European nations began to view Asia and Africa as a source of much needed raw materials (coal, iron, and copper) AND a new market to send their manufactured goods. Early European imperialism was in the form of small colonies, trading posts, and missionary work, but that was beginning to change.
