Evaluating the Performance of an Organisation An organisational assessment is a systematic process for obtaining valid information about the performance of an organisation and the factors that affect performance. It differs from other types of evaluations because the assessment focuses on the organisation as the primary unit of analysis.

### Evaluating the Performance of an Organisation | Better ...

An organizational evaluation includes the activities to improve an organization, usually by comparing the quality of its operations to some standard of high performance (this is an organizational assessment) and then recommending what changes should be made in order to bring that quality up to that standard (this expands the assessment into an organizational evaluation).
