The primary lane for the turtle diagram contains information for the key inputs, key process steps and key outputs.. Inputs - Enter details of the actual process input such as key information, reports, components, materials, schedules, requirements or other information. Inputs come from suppliers; some external suppliers but most frequently internal suppliers.
